TO THE UNITED DAUGHTERS OF THE CONFEDERACY:

The undersigned, residing at Pickens C. H. S. C.  
who is the widow of P. McDuffie Alexander  
a Confederate soldier, hereby presents this Certificate of Eligibility for a Southern Cross of Honor  
My husband entered the service of the Confederate States on the July  
day of 1861, as a Private  
in Company A of the Over Rife Regiment Capt J W Livingston in  
Command Volunteers C. S. A., and was at that time a resident  
of Pickens District. He was killed at the battle of  
\_\_\_\_\_ or died from exposure, or was honorably discharged  
from said service at the surrender of Gen Lee at Appomattox  
April 1865, on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of  
1865, at which time he held the rank of  
Wounded on the battle field of Virginia 1863.

In securing this Cross of Honor, I solemnly affirm I shall abide by the rules and regulations governing the bestowal of the Cross, and shall under no circumstances either wear it or allow it to be worn.
