Woods and Capt. John Mackey Greenville County, S.C. C. S. A., and was at that time a resident of _____

He was honorably discharged from service by Ch. Woods after the sur- render & the destruction of shops by Sherman's army on the 10th day of May 1865 at which time he held the rank of Private
