The undersigned, residing at Liberty who is an Ex-Confederate Soldier and a member of Camp No. 1023 U. C. Vs., hereby, at your request, presents this Certificate of Eligibility for a Confederate Cross of Honor.

He entered the service of the Confederate States on the day of August 1861, as a Private in Company K of the 10th Regiment of Volunteers

C. S. A., and was at that time a resident of Anderson District

He was honorably discharged from service by Gen Marshall on the 1 day of April 1865, at which time he held the rank of Private
