Confederate States on the 14th day of April 1861 as a Private

1861 in Company D of the 4th Regiment of S.C. Volunteers

Anderson County, S.C. served time out as Private Regt. 5 Co as Capt. continued over two years then resigned

He was honorably discharged from service by D.O.S.

and entered 101st Regt. Co. B 1st and remained until the war closed
