Confederate States on the February day of 1862 as a Private
in Company "M" of the Seventh Alabama Regiment of
Cavalry Volunteers
C. S. A., and was at that time a resident of Floyd County, Alabama
He was honorably discharged from service by Parole at Talladega,
Alabama on the Agria day of
1865 at which time he held the rank of
Private in same Regiment and Company
