To the United Daughters of the Confederacy:

The undersigned, residing at Liberty who is an Ex-Confederate Soldier and a member of Camp No. 1523, Surri U. C. Vs., hereby, at your request, presents this Certificate of Eligibility for a Confederate Cross of Honor. He entered the service of the Confederate States on the day of October 1861, as a Private in Company B of the 10. S. C. Regiment of 2nd Volunteers, C. S. A. and was at that time a resident of Greenville S. C.

He was honorably discharged from said service by Gen. McCollum, Greenville S. C. on the day of April 1865, at which time he held the rank of Private.
