To the United Daughters of the Confederacy:

The undersigned, residing at Pierces, SC, R. D. #1, who is an Ex-Confederate Soldier and a member of Camp No. 1523 U. C. Vs., hereby at your request presents this Certificate of Eligibility for a Confederate Cross of Honor. He entered the service of the Confederate States on the 1st day of November 1864 as a Private in Company "D" of the First Regiment of South Carolina Volunteers C. S. A. and was at that time a resident of Pierces District. He was honorably discharged from service by my Commander on the 9th day of April 1865 at which time he held the rank of Private.
