TO THE UNITED DAUGHTERS OF THE CONFEDERACY:

The undersigned, residing at Richmond, S.C. who is an ex-Confederate soldier and a member of Camp No. 1523, U. C. V.'s, hereby, at your request, presents this Certificate of Eligibility for a Confederate Cross of Honor. He entered the service of the Confederate States on the Aug. 1862, as a Private in Company "K" of the 62nd Regiment of S.C. Volunteers, C. S. A., and was at that time a resident of Lumberville, S.C. He was honorably discharged from service by Gen. Johnson on the 17 day of April, 1865, at which time he held the rank of private.
