TO THE UNITED DAUGHTERS OF THE CONFEDERACY :

The undersigned, residing at Pickens, S.C., R. F. D. # 2 who is the son of Ira James a Confederate soldier, hereby presents this Certificate of Eligibility for a Southern Cross of Honor. My father entered the service of the Confederate States on the day of , 186, as a private in Company "E" of the First Regiment South Carolina Volunteers C. S. A., and was at that time a resident of Pickens District (S.C.) He was killed in the battle of "Blow up" at Sullivan Island or died from exposure, or was honorably discharged from said service by on the day of 1864, at which time he held the rank of private

In securing this Cross of Honor, I solemnly affirm I shall abide by the rules and regulations governing the bestowal of the Cross, and shall under no circumstances either wear it or allow it to be worn
