presents this Certificate of Eligibility for a Confederate Cross of Honor. He entered the service of the
Confederate States on the 15 day of June 1861 as a private
in Company E of the Hampton Legion Regiment of
S. C. Volunteers

C. S. A., and was at that time a resident of Greenville, S.C.

He was honorably discharged from service by General Lee
on the 15 day of

April 1865 at which time he held the rank of
private in company E in the H. L.
