To the United Daughters of the Confederacy:

The undersigned, residing at Pickens, South Carolina, who is an Ex-Confederate Soldier and a member of Camp No.

U. C. Vs., hereby, at your request, presents this Certificate of Eligibility for a Confederate Cross of Honor. He entered the service of the Confederate States on the 13th day of May 1862, as a Private in Company "D" of the Hampton Legion Regiment of South Carolina Volunteers,

..... C. S. A. and was at that time a resident of Greenville County, South Carolina

He was honorably discharged from said service by Capt Charles Furman, (having been transferred to Co "K" 16 S.C. Vol) at the Surrender day of 1865, at which time he held the rank of Private in Co "K" 16 S.C. Vol.
