The undersigned, residing at Pickens County who is an Ex-Confederate Soldier and a member of Camp No. U. C. Vs., hereby, at your request, presents this Certificate of Eligibility for a Confederate Cross of Honor.

He entered the service of the Confederate States on the 7 day of April 1861, as a Private in Company of the 4th I.C. Regiment of Infantry Volunteers

C. S. A., and was at that time a resident of Anderson District

He was honorably discharged from service by Col. Sloan on the 9 day of April 1865, at which time he held the rank of Private
